3. There is 1 space between Kelp and Pearl.
4. Shell is somewhere to the left of Pearl.

Places: Bench, Cafe, Pier, Garden

- 1. The book was found at the pier.
- 2. The scarf belongs to Mira or Nox.
- 3. Fern did not leave anything at the garden.
- 4. The key was not found at the cafe.
- 5. The thing at the pier belongs to Mira or Nox.
- 6. The key belongs to Mira or Tavi.
- 7. The thing at the garden belongs to Mira or Fern.
